Biography	Walter Cunningham Hume (1840 – 1921) was a surveyor and Chief Commissioner for Lands for Queensland. He and his wife Katie, daughter Ethel, brother Washington Hume, and members of both their families in England. They lived at Drayton, Toowoomba, and Brisbane.

- BB/1 – 5** Hume, Walter Cunningham, diaries and notebooks (6): 1859 to 60, on board S.S. Pera, notes on his reading; 1863 to 1864, account of official visit to western Maranoa; 1884, Brisbane and Toowoomba, district Land Courts; 1893 to 1895, diaries of two voyages to Sydney, one to Hobart; 1898 further visit to western Queensland.

- BB/6 – 11** Hume, Walter Cunningham, diaries (6): 1884, 1902, 1903 to 1905, 1909, describing overseas trips with his wife, and leave in England.
- BE** Hume, Walter Cunningham, autograph album of signatures cut from letters and pasted in bound volume. 14 x 18 cm half-bound in leather.
- CA** Hume, Ethel Stansfield, letters (91) 10 Sep 1875 to 3 Jun 1896 to her parents Walter and Kate Hume, written from school in England, finishing school in Dresden, or from the homes of friends and relatives in England and Scotland. A few letters are to her brother Bertram, or her aunt Sophie Fowler.
Forrest, Mabel, letter 29 Oct 1904 to Ethel Hume congratulating her on her engagement to William Maxwell.
Barlow, Gerald H, letter 28 Jul 1929 to Ethel [Maxwell] to tell her of his mother's death.
Barlow, Fred W, letters (2) 26 Jun 1934, 21 Sep 1934 to Ethel Maxwell, long letters with family and general news of Toowoomba and Brisbane affairs.
- CB** Hume, Ethel Stansfield, letters (23) to Ethel Hume, 1904 to 1905 congratulating her on her engagement to William Maxwell.
- CC** Hume, Ethel Stansfield, diary Jun 1898 to Jan 1903; 1898 to 1901 in Australia, 1901 to 1903 in England.
- D** Fowler, Maria, letter 26 Jan 1870 to Walter Hume [son-in-law] re loan to assist him in buying property in Queensland.
Hume Washington, Letter 6 Aug 1868 to Alice Fowler giving news of Walter and Kate Hume and family, with whom he was then living.
Fowler, Maria, letter 15 Jan 1884 to Kate Hume [sister], family news.
- D/1** Drake, Walter, letter 22 Dec 1922 to Ethel Maxwell, personal, enclosing photograph.
