Contents

Much of the material in this collection was prepared for a series of residences and plans to be published in the Sunday Mail. Little material can be positively identified. Some of these items have numbers on the reverse which appear to signify that these were plans for actual jobs undertaken by Da Costa. A distinct Spanish influence can be discerned in many of the houses. Many of the plans bear the initials A or B, A meaning wooden construction and B denoting brick construction. The material has been divided into 4 sections, the items A.1 - A.40 being a numbered series with notes of preparation for printing in the Sunday Mail; the items B.1 - B.18 are drawings and floor plans which have been prepared for publishing but are unnumbered; the items C.1 - C.8 which have also been prepared for the Sunday Mail but appear to form another distinct series, and the items D.1 - D.30 which include perspective drawings and floor plans with little identification, preliminary drawings and newspaper clippings.

Biography

Born in Townsville 1889; died in Brisbane 1974. A pupil of T.S. Martin, Sydney 1905 to 1907, C.B. Da Costa was employed by the Queensland Railways Department from 1907 to 1921. He practiced as an architect from 1921 to 1935, after which he re-entered the Queensland State Public Service where he was appointed Principal Railway Architect from 1938 to 1955.
