<b>Contents</b>	Newspaper cuttings, 1904 to 1924, form bulk of the collection. Also included : personal diaries relating to Ipswich social life and Welsby's railway duties, 1906 to 1914; notebooks, receipts, brochures, notices, papers relating to Queensland Party, correspondence.
<b>Date range</b>	1903 to 1964
<b>Biography</b>	Albert Welsby worked on the railways. He was associated with the Ipswich branch of the Workers Educational Association of Queensland and the Civic Reform League.
<b>Notes</b>	Unrestricted access. This collection contains material formerly catalogued at UQFL477 PIC260 – PIC266, PIC308 – PIC309, PIC349 – 355.

Programme. [1930] The Civic Reform League was formed in 1930 with the aim of complete reorganization of municipal government in Brisbane. Its policy called for reduction in expenditure and rates, reduction of the number of aldermen and the adoption of a city manager system.

This chart accompanied pamphlet by W. E. Trantmann entitled *One Great Union*, published by the Workers International Industrial Union.

Leaflet refers to Soviet strategy in Asia and the Pacific and the Australian Communist Party participation in conference in Peking organized by the Pan-Pacific Secretariat of the World Federation of Trade Unions.

The truth about the Soviet Union: [invitation to a series of ten lantern lectures by F. W. Paterson on the political, economic, and cultural development of the Soviet Union] / under the auspices of the Brisbane Labour College. [19??]
