**Biography** Susan Cochrane grew up in Papua New Guinea and has

lived and worked in the Pacific region for many years. In 1995 she was commissioned to study the feasibility of a department of contemporary Pacific art and establishing a major collection for the Tjibaou Cultural Centre in New

Caledonia. She was head of the Department of

Contemporary Pacific Art until 1998. She has completed

M.A. (Hons) and doctoral degrees in art history,

specialising in contemporary Pacific and Aboriginal art. As director of PacificLink Arts consultants, she has organised projects for Pacific artists and curated a number of significant exhibitions. In 1996 and 1999 she was the selector for Melanesia for the Queensland Art Gallery's Asia Pacific Triennial. Her extensive writing on the Pacific region draws on years of research and

curatorial activities in the field, and personal contacts with many Pacific artists. She is the author of *Contemporary* 

Art in Papua New Guinea (1997), Aboriginal Art

Collections: Highlights from Australia's Public Museums and Galleries (2000), Beretara: Contemporary Pacific Art (2001), and the forthcoming Art and Life in Melanesia.

In 1989 Cochrane established Pacificlink Arts Consultants to undertake fieldwork, research, project management and acquisitions of contemporary Pacific art and to curate exhibitions and publish and promote indigenous artists and their art. In addition to Pacificlink Arts Consultants, Cochrane was also involved in PNG Arts Advisors with Hugh Stevenson and Joseph Nalo.

Cochrane has also worked as Arts Advisor for Bulabula Arts in Ramingining, Northern Territory in 1993 to 1994 and from 1996 to 1999 was the Head of Department, Contemporary Pacific Art at the Tjibaou Cultural Centre in Noumea. Here she was appointed by the Agence de Development de la Culture Kanak to establish the Department of Contemporary and Pacific and Kanak art, to devise the program of exhibitions and other activities for the inauguration of the Cultural Centre and to research and advise on the acquisition of a major collection of contemporary Pacific art.
