**Biography** Queensland Association of Professional Anthropologists and Archaeologists (Q.A.P.A.A.) was formed in the early 1980s to provide a professional voice in Queensland to speak out on issues such as the Seasman Commission on Aboriginal land rights in Western Australia. Related to this were concerns about Queensland cultural heritage legislation, sand mining on Moreton Island, and the preservation of Aboriginal sites and relics. For most of its time, it was mainly inactive and in 1989 Bruce Rigsby wrote to members with a suggestion of dissolving the Association.

Professor Bruce Rigsby was with the University of Queensland Anthropology Department.
