Biography John Railton studied architecture at the University of Queensland from 1955 to

1958 before moving to Melbourne to work with Bates Smart and McCutcheon, and graduating from the University of Melbourne in 1960. After working on various projects in Sydney, he returned to Brisbane in 1962 and established his own architecture practice while teaching part time at the University of Queensland. During this time, he designed his home and office, the Railton House at Grenier Street in Spring Hill. In 1971, Railton relocated to the United States of America, where he focused on residential projects, working in New York and Cleveland, Ohio. After a brief return to Sydney from 1980 to 1982, Railton returned to the United States, settling in Colorado where he continued his focus on residential projects. Since 2001, he has lived and practiced in

Maleny, Queensland.
