Contents	Manuscripts, correspondence, newspaper cuttings, sketches, photographs, publications
Biography	The Wienholt family were a pioneering family in the Darling Downs and Fassifern areas. They owned numerous pastoral stations, including Jondaryan station. Much of this collection relates to Arnold Wienholt Jnr. who was a pastoralist, Queensland Legislative Assembly member, House of Representatives member, big-game hunter in Africa, and scout in Africa during World War I. Most of the papers in the collection are by William Wienholt.

Letter [n.d.], Durban [to unidentified] Major. Writes of events in Angola and German East Africa. Between 1914 and 1916, Arnold Wienholt was a scout and intelligence officer with the British forces in Angola Rhodesia and German East Africa.

- 26 – 81** Letters to Brenda Wienholt, 1913 to 1919. Letters written from Grassmere Station, Qld; Brisbane; Cape Town; German Southwest Africa; Angola; Rhodesia; Blue Mountains. N.S.W.; Melbourne; Bombay; Portuguese East Africa. Writes of personal news, his defeat in federal election 1913 for seat of Wide Bay, and news and events during his stay in Africa. He was a big game hunter in Africa and scout and intelligence officer for British forces during World War 1.

Correspondence: outgoing, 1942 – 1971. Includes letters concerning Wienholt family and his biography of Arnold Wienholt.
