Biography	Elaine Marlay was born 9 October 1915. She was admitted to the degree of Bachelor of Dental Science with Second Class Honours, University of Queensland, 1937. She received her PhD in 1969, was appointed Temporary Lecturer in Oral Biology in January 1965 and was promoted to Senior Lecturer in Oral Biology in 1971. She died on 4 May 1977. Elaine Marlay's <i>A history of dental education in Queensland 1863 – 1964</i> was published by the University of Queensland Department of Dentistry in 1979.
